



Article I: Organization

The organizer, the association De la Plage aux Étoiles, located at the Town Hall of Collioure, 3 rue de la République, 66190 Collioure, has in the village of Collioure, a scavenger hunt called "Planet Hunt." The prizes of the Hunt are divided into two categories:

- Small Lots: pens and key rings from the Paris Observatory and bandanas from past Collioure festivals
- Jackpots: astronomy books (one book per day)

Planet Hunt is a puzzle game. In the event of multiple jackpot winners, the winner will be decided by lottery. The members of the association De la Plage aux Étoiles are only ones who know the locations of the planets and their keywords. They agree not to participate in the Planet Hunt, and not to disclose the locations or keywords of the planets, under penalty of exclusion from the association.

Article II: Participation

Participation is open to everyone.

Participation is for individuals only and a participant may not under any circumstances play under several pseudonyms or on behalf of other participants.

Article III: Modalities

The Planet Hunt is will take place from July 26, 2021 at 12:01 a.m. until Sunday August 1, 2021 at 6 p.m. Participation is possible at any time during this period.

Planet Hunt is free.

To participate in The Planet Hunt, all you have to do is search for the posters of the 8 planets of the solar system scattered around Collioure. The starting point is the Sun located at the the olive tree on the Place de l'Eglise. The Sun, the

planets and their respective orbits are all represented on the same scale. Each planet is located in its orbit. From the 4th planet (Mars), clues are placed on each orbit and indicate their advance / delay in relation to the planet. Participants must note the keywords associated with each planet on the answer card available on each flyer of the festival. When they have obtained the 8 keywords, participants must hand in their answer card with their contact details to the festival reception at the Cultural Center of Collioure. If participants incur costs for the Planet Hunt, the Star Beach Association will not be able to reimburse them under any circumstances. We remind you that this Planet Hunt being carried out in the public domain, children are the responsibility of their parents.

Article IV: Endowment

- Small Lots: pens and key rings from the Paris Observatory and bandanas from past Collioure celebrations
- 7 jackpots can be awarded, each one being a book:

 - Big bang by Jean-Philippe Uzan, Flammarion Editions

 - How we pee in space, Pierre François Mouriaux, Fleurus
 - The Paris Observatory, 350 Years of Science, Co-edition Gallimard-Observatoire de Paris
 - In the Combi by Thomas Pesquet, Marion Montaigne, Éditions Dargaud

Article V: Designation of winners

Any participant bringing back the 8 keywords is automatically awarded a prize from the Small Lots.

He or she may also attempt to win the jackpot (book) on the day he or she turns in his or her full answer card. A jackpot will be awarded each day at 6 p.m. by drawing lots from the complete answer card received on the same day. Any answer card deposited after 6 p.m. will be counted for the following day. If only one participant has found all 8 keywords on a given day, he or she automatically wins the jackpot. If several participants have found the 8 keywords on a given day, the drawing of lots is carried out by one of the members of the association present at 6 p.m. at the Cultural Center of

Collioure. The owner of the ballot drawn wins a jackpot and can choose it from the books not yet awarded.

Each individual can only complete one answer card and can therefore only try their luck for a jackpot once a week.

Article VI: The Planet Hunting Rules

The rules can be amended at any time in the form of an amendment by the organizer in compliance with the conditions set out, and published by online announcement on the site www.astrocollioure.fr. Any participant who refuses the modification(s) must cease participation in the Planet Hunt. The full Rules are available on the page <http://www.astrocollioure.fr> and a paper version is available throughout the Festival at the Collioure Cultural Center.

Article VII: Disputes and responsibilities

Participation in this Planet Hunt implies unreserved acceptance of the rules in their entirety. If one or more provisions of these Rules were declared null or inapplicable, the other clauses would retain all their force and scope. Any inaccurate or false declaration, or any other fraud will result in the disqualification of the participant. The association De la Plage aux Étoiles, represented by its office, will rule on any dispute relating to La Chasse aux Planètes and its regulations.

The organizer reserves the right, if the circumstances so require, to shorten, modify or cancel this Planet Hunt in accordance with the conditions set out. No liability is accepted on behalf of the Planet Hunt organizers and/or staff.

Article VIII: Attribution of competence

Any dispute that cannot be settled amicably will be submitted to the competent courts designated under the Code of Civil Procedure.

Article IX: Data processing and Freedoms

The personal information collected within the framework of this Planet Hunt is processed in accordance with the Data Protection Act of January 6, 1978. All participants have, pursuant to article 27 of this law, a right access or rectification of data concerning them. Any request for access, rectification or opposition should be addressed to the association De la Plage aux Étoiles.

Article X: Publication of the end of The Hunt for the Planets

The Planet Hunt will be over on Sunday August 1st at 6 p.m. The Plage aux Étoiles association will list the names of the winners, and reveal the location of the planets and their key words, at the start of the last Festival conference, at the Collioure Cultural Center at 6:05 pm.

Article XII: Acceptance of the Rules

All participants in the Planet Hunt accept these rules without reservation or restriction.
